Turn to Matthew 5 and Ephesians 4

Matthew 5:13 – "<u>Ye are the salt</u> of the earth: but <u>if the salt have lost his savour</u>, wherewith shall it be salted? <u>it is thenceforth good for nothing</u>, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men."

-"ye are the salt" - those that are saved.

-salvation is the point when you own up to your guilt as a sinner and trust Christ as your Savior

-are you saved tonight?

-"if the salt have lost his savour" – a Christian should be Christ-like

-if you claim to trust Christ, do you act like a Christ?

-think, act, believe, speak like Christ in all circumstances?

-very interesting object illustration - salt loosing it's flavor

-salt makes certain foods extra good

-corn on the cob with butter and SALT

-hot greasy French fries with SALT

-hot potato with butter and SALT

-hot pretzel with SALT

-Ramen noodles with chicken seasoning that is loaded with SALT

-what if the salt you used on all of these foods had no added flavor?

-if would just be bland and you would throw the salt away

-"it is thenceforth good for nothing"

-salt with no flavor is good for nothing

-a Christian that is not Christ-like is also good for nothing

-Jesus Christ is making a very bold statement in this common passage.

-someone who claims allegiance to the name of Christ but does not

represent a life dedicated to Christ is good for nothing

The distinct flavor of salt is what makes salt useful and desirable.

-Salt has to be different from everything else in order for it to make an impact.

-What are the distinct differences of a Christian that allows them to make an impact in those around them?

Title: The distinction of a Christian

3 Distinctions of a Christian: Striving, forgiving, loving

1. Striving for Christ-likeness

Eph 4:30-31

[**30**] And <u>grieve not</u> the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. [**31**] Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

"Grieve not the holy Spirit of God" – God will be prodding you to live with excellence

-Every Christian ought to be striving for excellence in every area, especially spiritually.

-striving for excellence requires doing what you don't feel like doing

-striving for excellence means doing right when others are not

-striving for excellence means giving your best when it is most inconvenient -Don't give God your good but give God your best

-Good, better, best. Never let it rest. Until your good becomes better and your better becomes best!

-It is very difficult to live like Christ in our godless society

-making no effort to be different will result in Christians losing their flavor -In what ways should a Christian be striving?

1. Strive to be holy

-1 Pt 1:15 – "But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation"

-Eph 4:22-24 - put off, put on principle

-remove sin, add righteousness

- -The key is in verse 23 with what you "put in" you
- 2. Strive to stay connected with God

-takes effort to read, study, meditate and memorize God's Word -John 15:3-5 - Now ye are <u>clean through the word</u> which I have spoken unto you.[4] <u>Abide in me</u>, and I in you. As the branch cannot

bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.[5] I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for <u>without</u> <u>me ye can do nothing</u>.

-illustration: baking soda and vinegar need to be mixed together in order to make a reaction

-Truth of Bible in your mind mixed with the Spirit in your heart causes a reaction that will change you from the inside out -a Christian that relies on the church for their only spiritual growth will eventually wither away like leaves on a limb cut from a branch

3. Strive to share the gospel

-Jude 21-23 - [21] Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

[22] And of some have compassion, making a difference:

-we live in a day filled with negative news everywhere. -share the good news of the gospel

What makes a Christian distinct from other people?

-They strive for excellence – holy, abiding, sharing

2. Forgiving the undeserving

Ephesians 4:32 - "And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, <u>forgiving</u> one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you."

-If saved, God forgave you of all your sin

-YOU ARE GUILTY OF SIN BEFORE GOD

-bad attitude, bitterness, gossip, pride, sowing discord...

-GOD FORGAVE YOU when you confessed your sin

-we need to forgive others like God has forgiven us

-it's easy to forgive people for small offences when they are begging to be forgiven

-everyone can forgive the easy ones

-What about the hard one?

-How about big offences?

-How about offences when they don't ask for forgiveness?

-How about offences when they don't even care that they offended you?

-How about offences when they are glad they hurt you?

-Only a Christian depending on God can forgive like God.

-There is no sin Jesus can't forgive

-With God's help, you can forgive any offense

-In fact, you can't be right with God until you get right with others

- Matthew 6:14-15 – God will only forgive you if you forgive others

- Matthew 5:23-24 – seek out forgiveness from others you know are mad at you

What makes a Christian distinct from other people?

-they forgive the undeserving

3. Loving the unlovable Eph 5:1-2 [1] Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children;

[2] And <u>walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us</u>, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

-Christ demonstrated the ultimate example of love -we are to love others as Christ loved us

Gal 5:13-15 – For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but <u>by love serve one another</u>. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; <u>Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself</u>. But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

1 Cor 13:4-7, Romans 12:9-21 – examples on how to show love

- -patient
- -kind
- -want what is best for others

-selfless

- -thinks good of others
- -give the benefit of the doubt
- -bearing hardships
- -believing
- -hoping
- -genuine (not hypocritical)
- -hate evil
- -love good
- -prefer others over self
- -pray for others
- -give to the needs of others
- -hospitality
- -meet people where they are happy or sad
- -be humble
- -don't be a know it all

People know you are a Christian by your love for eachother

John 13:34-35 – A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one for another.

Matthew 5:43-48 - love your enemies

-<u>love</u> enemies

-<u>bless</u> them that curse you

-<u>pray</u> for those that take advantage of you and attack you

-"what do you more than others?" if you just love those that love you

It's easy to love those that are nice, kind and giving

Romans 12:19-21

[19] Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

[20] Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

[21] Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

The distinction of a Christian is one that will love the most difficult to love

Conclusion:

-Are you a Christian that has lost their distinction?

-Are you just like everyone else?

-Would God consider your life "good for nothing" in the cause for Christ because you are no different from the rest of those around you?

-If we are going to make a difference in our families, church or community, we need to have the distinct characteristics of a Christian.

-Striving for excellence when it is hard – holiness, abiding, sharing

-what sin do you need to confess?

-what part of your walk with God have you been neglecting?

-who do you need to be sharing the gospel with?

-forgiving the undeserving

-who are you bitter towards or holding a grudge against?

-who do you need to forgive?

-who do you need to ask for forgiveness?

-loving the unlovable

-who do you hate?

-who do you need to love?
