

Where we are currently:

- Began Exclusively Livestreaming only all ministries March 15
- Phase 1 – May 31 – June 21
 - Split morning worship services, 9:00 & 10:30 am
 - Regular Sunday evening and Wednesday evening service
 - No Sunday School or other ministries

REOPENING PLAN

June 28 & July 5

- Combine the 2 morning worship services
- Continue Sunday evening and Wednesday evening services

July 12 (four months after initial closing)

- Return to normal meeting schedule
- Open nursery and children's ministries
- Open all ministries including Youth, RU
- Selective van pick-up as opposed to full bus ministry

SAFE WORSHIPPING PRACTICES REMAINING IN PLACE:

- Continue with offering boxes
- Drinking fountains will remain closed – bottled water available
- No shared food or drinks in classrooms
- Bulletins will be available in lobbies as opposed to being handed out
- Greeters and ushers will have limited duties – directing but not handshaking
- Building will be sanitized between services
- As always, asking those who have had a fever in the last 24 hours or do not feel well to stay home
